SCIENCE ART: Science Art for Room 104...Come explore explore the creative end of science with Ms. Holderness & her artist friend Ayars. Make a mural or work on a sculpture, spruce up the room and have fun. Healthy snacks & a little bit of cooking. Start thinking about what you'd like to contribute!

YOGA: Namaste! It's getting chilly out there. Warm your mind and soul with some relaxing yoga moves. Concentrate and release the stress of the day. Join Brenda from Flo Yoga Studios in this popular class

BREAKDANCE: Back by popular demand -- learn new styles and break it down on the dance floor. You don't have to be a pro to have fun. Just bring comfy clothes and a eager attitude.

CLAY SCULPTURE: Get messy and creative with Ms. Massucco and design your own clay bowls and other fun sculptures.

BFMS NEWSLETTER: Be part of a fantastic team of editors and help publish the student newsletter. *5th and 6th graders that wish to participate need a written recommendation from their Language Arts teacher.*

PAPIER MACHE - REPTILES: Students will bend, twist and sculpt wire armatures – ‘skeletons’ - in the basic shapes of frog, turtle, lizard, etc. Then we'll build up the ‘muscle’ with layers of papier mache, until the reptiles really take shape! Finally, we paint the ‘skin’ – adding the color and detail that will bring our reptiles to life! No feeding or cleaning of cages required with these creatures!

AFRICAN DANCE: Expand your cultural knowledge. Learn the art of African Dance - a rhythmic and historical form of expression that dates back to the pre-Colonial area. Guaranteed to be fun.

PAPIER MACHE - TOTEM POLE: Students will work together to design an 8-10 foot totem pole, selecting totems for the coming year from traditional designs. Starting with sauna tubes, we will build the forms with wire and recycled/found materials, before applying layers of papier mache. Finally, students will paint the totem pole in traditional colors, and seal it with urethane. Final result will be displayed at Maplewing Artisans in Bellows Falls and auctioned at a raffle.

MURAL ART: Let's continue to make this building beautiful! Join Jeannette Stealy (who designed the cafeteria mural) in another mural. Bring your creativity and originality!

CHESS CLUB: Calling all Chess lovers! Improve your technique, compete with your peers and learn a new strategy in this popular game!

JEWELRY MAKING: Design and make jewelry! Earrings, bracelets, necklaces and more. Items will be donated to a local charity.

MAD SCIENCE- JR. EXPLORER: Work with 3D technology to make a motion picture, build your own mini-machines, design your own toy, inspect authentic insect specimens! Join the exciting team of Mad Science in this exploratory class! Limited to 15 students.
