**iPod Touch Security and restrictions**

1. Setting restrictions (YouTube, install apps, location, Safari, iTunes, explicit iPod content)
2. On the touch, tap **Settings**>>**General**>>**Restrictions**. Next, tap **Enable Restrictions** and enter a four-digit code. This will let you lock the settings. Now, you'll have several features you can switch off. These are Explicit iPod Content, Safari, YouTube, iTunes and Installing Apps.
